Subject: Guidance for SSD 3 Conversion to DLC 3

Leaders,

From the Commandant of the Noncommissioned Officer Leadership Center of Excellence.

1. As you may be aware, in support of the NCO 2020 strategy, all levels of SSD are being converted to DLC, starting with the conversion of SSD level 1 to DLC level 1.
2. On 01 July 2019, enrollment into SSD level 3 will be discontinued and enrollment into DLC 3 starts. Soldiers currently enrolled in SSD 3 who have not completed the course will have until 29 February 2020 to complete the course. Soldiers failing to complete SSD 3 by 29 February 2020 will be disenrolled and enrolled by their component quota source managers into DLC 3. Soldiers in the grade of E-6 currently not enrolled in SSD 3 will be enrolled into DLC 3 on 01 July 2019 by their component quota source managers. Soldiers in the grade of E-6 having completed SSD 3 will be given full credit and will not be required to take DLC 3. Between 01 July 2019 and 29 February 2020, SSD 3 and DLC 3 will run concurrently in the Army Learning Management System (ALMS). 01 July 2019 DLC 3 will be opened for enrollment in the Army Training Resource Requirements System (ATRRS), soldiers in the grade of E-6 will be enrolled by their component quota source managers and must complete DLC 3 in order to attend resident PME.
3. Conversion for each subsequent SSD levels 4 through 5 will be converted to the requisite DLC levels 4 through 5 at a later date. A new DLC 6 is also being developed and guidance for DLC 4 through 6 will be announced in a follow on HQDA G-3 message.
4. The expiration date of this message is 01 February 2020.
